Fighting for student press freedoms.


## In Georgia:

Schools still have the legal right to censor student journalists' speech when they communicate through school-sponsored media.

Teacher-advisers can be disciplined and even fired for supporting student press freedoms.

Your peers who publish content through non-school sponsored media are protected from school censorship under the First Amendment.

The U.S. Supreme Court decided in Hazelwood School District v. Kuhlmeier that schools can censor student journalists for an education-related purpose.
